In case of Fire

In case of fire, there are anti-fire blankets by the kitchen oven and in the rooms, and a fire extinguisher, on a tripod behind the entrance door. While extinguishing the fire, switch off the gas supply (see Gas section below).

If needed, call directly the fire station of Colares and, in all cases, call the hosts (see phone numbers above).

Electricity

In case of a total power failure, a first check should be done in the main circuit breaker, right outside the kitchen. In case of partial failure, the corresponding circuit breakers are accessible from the electricity cabinet in the kitchen, on the wall by the fridge. Circuit breakers for local zones are accessible in the corridors.

Gas

The only devices in the kitchen that run on gas are the stove and oven (gas is supplied by canisters in a separate annex on the kitchen outside, and controlled:

- a) inside: by a tap, behind the stove; and
- b) outside: by a tap switch and taps in each of the gas bottles.

Internet

High speed (fiber) Wi-Fi is available from a router behind the TV set.

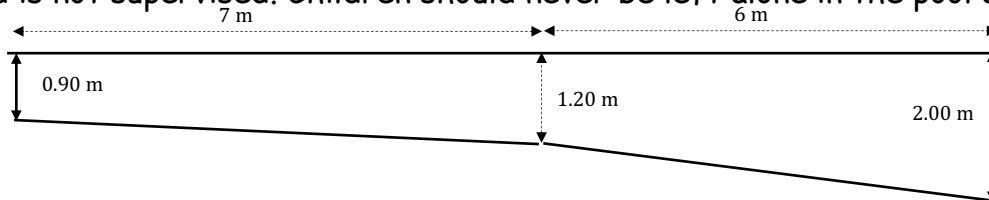

Keys

There are 3 sets of keys (main door and remote control for the gate - the additional key is to be used in case of remote control failure). The other two keys in keychain on the bowl are for the two doors by the swimming pool (toilette and pool kitchen).

Swimming Pool and Barbecue

The pool depth varies from about 90cm near the stairs and 200 cm in the opposed end of the pool, as shown in the figure below. The swimming pool has no guaranteed safety fence and is not supervised. Children should never be left alone in the pool area.



There is a barbecue (no coal provided) in the pool shed. The two doors of the pool house correspond to a toilette and a "kitchen" (the switches for the lights of all the swimming pool area are behind the door of this support room).

Water

Tap water inside the main house (kitchen and bathrooms) is supplied by the Sintra council and is perfectly safe to drink. The water is heated by solar panels supplemented, if necessary, by an electrical heat pump (in the annex behind the house).

In the garden and in the pool annex, the water is from a borehole and is not safe to drink, it should only be used for washing. The water in the pool annex is heated by an electric water heater, located in the pool kitchen.

Central Heating

Central heating is available in all house divisions provided by a heat pump and adjustable with a remote control next to the "blue" toilette (just off the living room).

Household Linen and Children

Complete household linen is provided (sheets and towels, including pool towels) for all guests. For stays longer than a week, linen is replaced weekly. Upon request, there are three travel cots and two highchairs available for small children.

Garbage

Separate garbage bins are provided (general, plastic, glass and paper). When full, they should be disposed of into the public containers (leave the gate to the right, all the way of the track road, and immediately to the right at Rua dos Pardinheiros)
